Thank you for your interest in using Lewis Ginter Botanical Garden as a source of imagery for your artwork. We welcome you here at the Garden, and ask for your cooperation so that your experience is productive, while preserving the Garden's beauty for all our guests.

Guidelines for artists working in the Garden:

- Please bring your own stool/seat and all supplies. Do not leave your equipment or opened painting supplies unattended.
- You are free to choose your location, however certain venues may be unavailable due to previously scheduled Garden and/or private events, or routine maintenance.
- Please do not set up within garden beds or disturb the plant collections, and please avoid blocking main paths and walkways.
- The Garden generally is irrigated early in the morning before opening at 9 a.m., so be mindful that shaded areas may remain damp until mid-morning.
- If you choose to work in the Conservatory you must use a drop-cloth to protect the absorbent stone.
- Please remember that food and beverages are not allowed outside in the Garden.
