



Group Visit Policies

Teachers and Chaperones

- Teachers and chaperones are responsible for assisting the Children's Garden educator during your scheduled program time.
- Additional adults and siblings will be asked to enjoy the Garden on their own during your scheduled program time.
- All attending adults are responsible for maintaining an educational environment during their groups' visit by being respectful of programs in session as well as other garden visitors.
- During your self-guided garden exploration time you will be asked to visit areas outside of the Children's Garden.
- Teacher and Chaperone Guides and a Scavenger Hunt are available to help teachers and chaperones engage students during their self-guided garden exploration.
- Assign students to chaperones prior to your arrival.
- Review Group Visit Policies with students and chaperones before your visit.
- During program time, limit cell phone use to emergencies ONLY.

Teachers, Chaperones and Students

- Lewis Ginter Botanical Garden is an outside, living museum. The Garden is for walking tours and explorations only. There are no playground areas available for active sports or running.
- Walking feet and speaking voices are expected in all areas of the Garden.
- Respect the plants and animals by staying on the pathways.
- Leave all plants and animals where you find them.
