



On the Day of Your Visit

Arrival

- Please arrive ten minutes before your scheduled class time to allow for walking time to the Children's Garden.
- As our daily schedule is usually filled, late arrivals will result in a shortened program or possible cancellation.
- If you are running late on the day of your program or are unable to attend your scheduled program, please call the Children's Garden Educators and leave a message at 804-262-9887 x239.

Parking

- School buses and vans drop-off students at the Children's Garden bus stop and park in the Bus Parking area.
- All personal vehicles bringing students must drop-off students at the Robins Visitor Center and park in the Visitor Parking lot.
- A map with parking and student drop-off locations is attached.
- Distribute maps to all drivers.

Accessibility

- The Children's Garden is universally accessible.
- Please let us know in advance if you have students with special needs.

Food

- Bring all snacks and lunches with you when you leave the bus.
- Eat lunch or snack in designated Picnic Area in the Children's Garden only.
- Indoor facilities for eating are not available.
- There is no food for purchase in the Children's Garden.

Dress

- Classes are held outside, regardless of the weather conditions.
- Teachers, students and chaperones should dress for an active, outside walk.

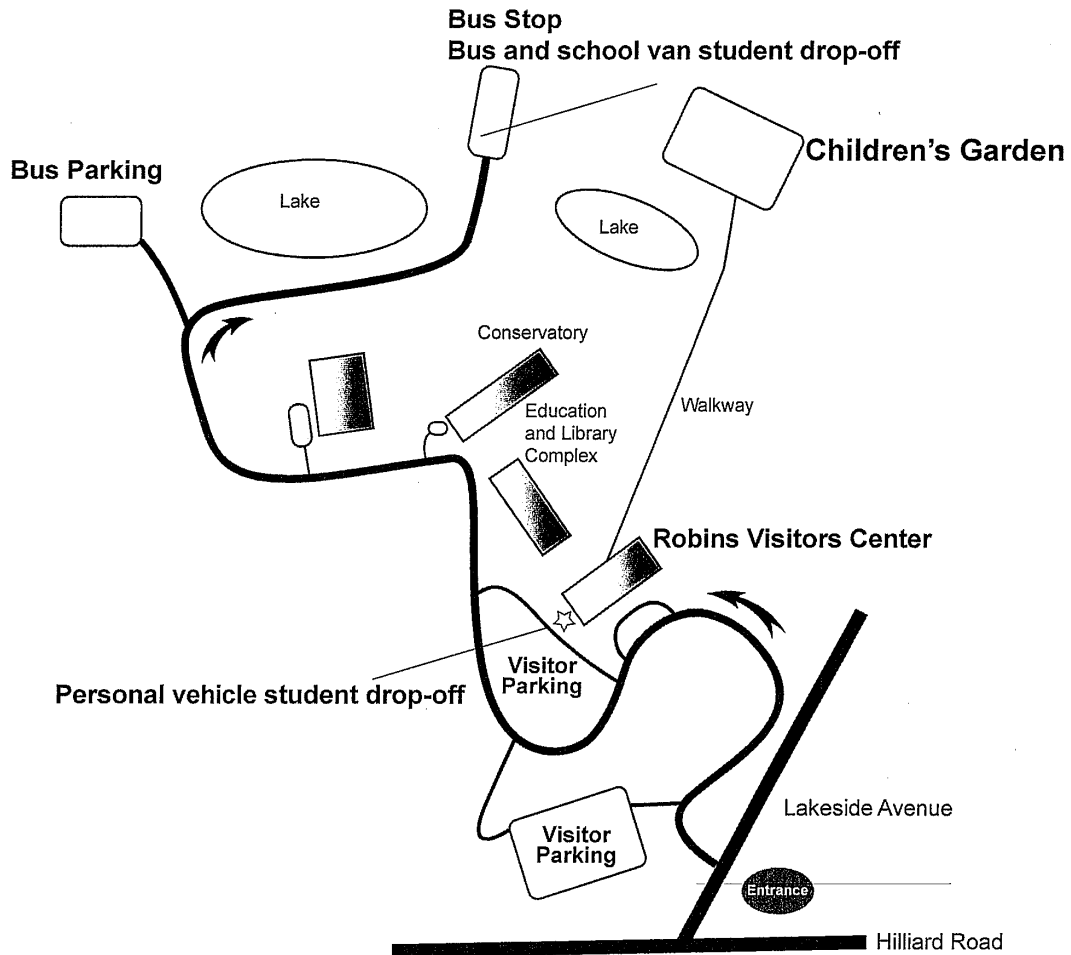
Student Drop-off and Parking

Personal Vehicles
