

## Lewis Ginter Botanical Garden Evening Tours

One of the best ways to experience Lewis Ginter Botanical Garden is a guided tour. Consider adding an evening tour to your next event – our trained Garden Guides will welcome your group and ensure your guests' visit is informative and memorable.

### 1. Evening Guided Tours

*Available with rental of all venues.*

- Choose a unique experience to entertain, enlighten and inform your group. Length of tour can be flexible; however, the Garden recommends one hour to one hour and fifteen minutes.

### 2. Central Garden and Conservatory Tour

*Available with rental of Robins Visitors Center only.*

- An informal tour offers guests free time to explore the Central Garden and Conservatory on their own. A Garden Guide will be available in each area (one in Central Garden and one in the Conservatory) to answer questions about plant material or the Garden.

\$250 (1 hr, 2 Garden Guides)

\$500 (2 hrs, 2 Garden Guides)

- A formal guided tour of the Central Garden and Conservatory. The garden recommends one Garden Guide for every 15 - 20 guests. Length of tour can be flexible; however, the Garden recommends at least forty-five minutes.

\$11 per person (minimum of 50 guests)

#### ***The Central Garden***

Uniting the Robins Visitors Center, the Conservatory, and the Education and Library Complex, the Central Garden includes three acres of progressing garden "rooms," featuring classical design and artistry, fascinating plants, intimate spaces and dramatic views. Rooms include the Four Seasons Garden, Healing Garden and Sunken Garden.

#### ***The Conservatory\****

The Conservatory is the "Jewel of the Garden." This 11,000 square-foot complex houses exotic and unusual plants from around the world in its permanent collection and features beautiful seasonal displays. Crowned by a 63-foot-tall dome, the Conservatory includes a central Palm House, a semi-tropical wing featuring our orchid collection, and two wings with changing themed displays full of seasonal color and interest.

*\*Please note that several Conservatory displays are seasonal and are in transition at certain times of the year. The Garden will make every attempt to make all displays available for your guests' enjoyment if an evening tour is scheduled, however it is possible that certain garden displays may be closed.*
