## Braille Alphabet

The six dots of
the braille cell are
arranged and numbered:

The capital sign, dot 6 , placed before a letter makes a capital letter.


The number sign, dots $3,4,5,6$, placed before the characters a through j , makes the numbers
1 through 0 . For example: a preceded by the number sign is $1, b$ is 2 , etc.
