Wednesday, May 4 – Wednesday, May 25

Note: This is a hybrid class. A strong internet connection is required to participate in this hybrid in-person/online class.

Week 1

May 4, 2022, 10 am – 3:30 pm | Meets In-Person

Day 1: In the classroom, with distribution of painting palettes, lecture, demos and information on how to access the online classroom, plus, how online instruction will function and how to prepare for our online orientation.

May 5, 2022, 10 am – 12:30 pm | Meets Virtually for Online orientation

Day 2: Students will receive a link to join orientation. Attendance is mandatory to ensure everyone is ready to proceed with the online portion of our class. Week 2 (Week of May 11, 2022)

Meets Online. Pre-recoded videos are available 24/7. New content is posted throughout the week. In this forum, students may ask questions, share comments and observations with the group. Participation is required by posting your color chart exercises into the private classroom. Stephey will be available LIVE online from 10am-12pm to answer questions and provide tips, simply pop in for immediate feedback. Note: Students are encouraged to work through the pre-recorded materials at their own pace. Once a section is complete the next section is

automatically released/unlocked and available to you. Students are expected to post class exercises for each section in the designated online classroom and all exercises need to be finished before the last day of class.

Week 3 (Week of May 18, 2021)

Online class continues. Pre-recoded videos are available 24/7. New content posted throughout the week. In this forum, students may ask questions, share comments and observations with the group. Week 4
