### Recommend materials provided by the student:

<p><b>Drawing Paper:</b> Sheila finds Stonehenge Aqua hot press to be a nice smooth paper for graphite. A few sheets of size 8X10 or 9X12 are suggested for this class.</p>
<p><b>Pencils:</b> Sheila recommends Caran d’Ache Grafwood pencils: HB and 2B. Amazon has a nice larger set if you are doing a lot of graphite. Some people like mechanical pencils, which are fine if you like them.</p>
<p><b>Erasers:</b> Everyone should have a good, kneaded eraser. Faber Castell is a common brand. A good white eraser is also useful.</p>
